Description of Organization

Responsibilities

- Regularly market the organization by posting on Facebook and Instagram
- Assist with updating the organization's website on Weebly
- Assist with other marketing and design tasks
- Meet regularly (in-person, phone, or video conference) with the Executive Director

Desired Qualifications

- Preferred knowledge of and experience in doing graphic design work, especially using Canva and MailChimp (but not required)
- Knowledge of administering and posting on a professional Facebook and Instagram page
- Ability to work independently and time management skills to prioritize projects and tasks in a timely manner to produce results

The internship is highly flexible, tailored to the student's schedule and needs. The internship will be 5-10 hours per week or the option to combine these job tasks with other responsibilities to meet the desired weekly commitment. Upon completion of 50 hours, students will receive a \$500 stipend. The ideal intern would commit to the spring and/or summer. Upon completion, the internship may be renewed for a longer period.
